- Analyse, evaluate and feedback on 1st team and Academy/23s matches (Academy and 23s responsibilities will be facilitating and managing a team of supporting analysts)
- Providing detailed 1st team opposition analysis, through the use of subjective and objective data in line with the Clubs philosophy and expectations.
- Produce pre-match analysis to aid pre match preparation.
- Live code first team matches to provide detailed feedback in relation to each fixture.
- Present detailed reports and feedback to the 1st Team Manager and key staff.
- Develop and maintain performance related databases for analytical reviews.
- Target set and develop individual player performance plans.
- Perform additional duties as required to meet the needs of the Club.
- To establish and grow the analysis department.
